

It is said that curiosity killed the cat. (Actually it was a lily.)

A curious cat taking just a nip of a lily's petal or leaf, licking the pollen or lapping water from the vase may result in severe, acute kidney failure or death in as little as 24 hours.

If your cat has ingested any part of a lily, call your veterinarian immediately or bring your cat (and the plant) to an emergency care facility.

Or call 24/7 Animal Poison Control Center at (855) 764-7661. The sooner treatment is started the better the prognosis.
